

Personal data processing clause

In relation to the implementation of the requirements of the Regulation (EC) No 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, "GDPR"), we inform about the principles of processing your personal data and about your rights with regard to it.

The below principles are applicable starting from 25 May 2018.

This information clause aims at facilitating the understanding what data we collect and why we collect them as well as what we use them for. The information is important, therefore, we ask you to familiarise yourself thoroughly with the document.

Who is the personal data controller?

The Controller is Kombinat 2000 sp. z o.o. with its registered office at the address: Kłoda 137, 64-130 Rydzyna.

What will your personal data be used for?

Your personal data are processed in order to establish contact, develop offers, sell food and hotel services and other as well as in order to maintain business relations, and to send commercial information within the meaning of the act on provision of services by electronic means.

On what basis will we process your personal data?

The basis for the processing of your personal data is Article 6 of the Regulation (EC) No 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR).

Is there a possibility to withdraw a consent?

Providing personal data is voluntary, it is not a statutory obligation nor a contractual one and it does not constitute a condition for concluding an agreement. Withdrawing a consent is possible at every stage and it is not related to any negative consequences. You may withdraw the consent in any way you choose (e-mail, traditional mail) so that the message on the withdrawal reaches the controller.

When and to whom may we transfer your data?

The controller does not transfer your personal data to third parties and the data are not used in automated processes such as profiling.

What can you do with the data you provide to us?

After consenting to the personal data processing, you have the right to demand that the controller provides you with access to your personal data, you have the right to obtain their copy and demand their rectification, deletion, limiting their processing and the right to object against their processing.

How long will your personal data be stored?

Until the consent is withdrawn or, if the data will be processed based on a legitimate interest of the controller – until you raise an objection.

What personal data are processed?

The categories of your personal data which are processed are the data which come directly from you (or were transferred on your behalf) or personal data which were collected from publicly available sources, in particular: name and surname, e-mail address, mobile telephone number, correspondence address.

The recipients of your personal data are employees and co-employees and auxiliary partners of the controller in its business activity.
