29th International Film Festival Etiuda&Anima

From a modest event presenting the achievements of film and art school students to an event of international character - this is how the history of the Etiuda&Anima festival, which will celebrate its jubilee next year, can be summarised. However, before it 'turns thirty,' its 29th edition is ahead of us. As the organisers promise, many surprises await the participants!

The International Film Festival Etiuda&Anima is the oldest film festival in Poland, confronting the achievements of students of film and art schools from all over the world and the acquis of artistic animation creators - professionals, students and independent filmmakers. The annual focal point of the event is two eponymous competitions with the following awards: the Golden, Silver and Bronze Dinosaurs and the Special Golden Dinosaur for the best film school of the festival in the student competition comprising feature and documentary short films; the Golden, Silver and Bronze Jabberwocky in the animation filmmakers' competition and the additional Special Golden Dinosaur Award is also presented annually to an outstanding educator and, at the same time, an active and artistically successful artist.

80th Kraków Christmas Crib Competition

1 December 2022 Main Market Square

The Kraków custom of 'walking from house to house' with a nativity scene dates back to the 19th century. However, after World War I, it began to disappear slowly. To preserve the crib-making tradition for future generations, Jerzy Dobrzycki, head of the magistrate's propaganda department, organised the first Kraków Christmas Crib Competition in 1937. After the Second World War, the competitions were resumed and their organisation. The Museum of Kraków has undertaken its organisation and continues the tradition. The competition aims to preserve and develop Kraków's nativity scene tradition, whose effect - the Krakow crib - crystallised over several decades and has become a worldwide phenomenon of established international renown and popularity. The competition is of great importance for promoting and popularising this unique product of intangible heritage.

Every year on the first Thursday of December (this year on 1 December 2022), crib makers bring their works to the Main Square and place them on the steps of the Adam Mickiewicz Monument, where they can be admired from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. After the Kraków bugle call at noon, a procession of cribs sets off around the Main Market Square, preceded by a folk band from Bronowice, leading to the stage where the crib makers and their works are presented. The creators then take their works to the Krzysztofory Palace, where they will be judged by a jury of historians, ethnographers, art historians, architects and artists.

The uniqueness of the phenomenon is underlined by its inclusion on the National List of Intangible Cultural Heritage in 2014. In addition, since 2018, the tradition of making nativity scenes is the first entry from Poland on the UNESCO Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.

Julia Wieniawa is an actress and singer with an extraordinary timbre of voice and musical sensitivity. Her debut was the song *Na zawsze*, released in 2016, which was included on the album 'Flirtini: Heartbreaks & Promises Vol. 3'. Subsequent singles - *Oddycham*, the double-platinum *Nie muszę* and the lyrical ballad SMRC - won the hearts of fans and established the singer's position in the music market. In 2021, the artist decided to collaborate with Maciej Musiałowski on the song *Zabierz tę miłość*, make a guest appearance with KARAŚ/ROGUCKI in the song *Bezpieczny Lot*, and also recorded the song *Sebiksy* with the duo Kacperczyk. After a few singles, for which there were also music videos - *Rozkosz*, *Nie mam dla Ciebie miłości* or *Milczysz* - in June 2022, Julia's long-awaited debut album entitled 'Hallucinations' was released. For her musical collaboration, the artist invited leading Polish producers Maciek Sawoch, Kuba Karaś and Wojtek Urbański. Electronic sounds interweave dance and lyrical melodies, and the whole is complemented by personal lyrics written in collaboration with Arek Kłusowski, Kasia Lins and Mery Spolsky.



Shortly after announcing his musical retirement in 2019, Ennio Morricone began working on a concert commemorating his musical legacy. A year later, as early as 2020, the Master completed the creative process, and the effects of his work will soon see the light of day.
