According to Art. 13 sec. 1 and 2 and art. 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation - hereinafter referred to as GDPR) (Journal of Laws of the European Union, L. of 2016, No. 119, p. 1, as amended) Bachleda Hotel Zakopane Sp. z o.o. informs that:

1. Administrator of the Contractor's personal data; Proxy (another person representing the Contractor); employee of the Contractor (persons indicated for contact / performance of the contract) is Bachleda Hotel Zakopane Sp. z o.o., hereinafter referred to as the Administrator.
2. The Administrator has appointed a personal data protection officer, whom you can contact at the following e-mail address: iod.r.andrzejewski@szkoleniaprawcze.com.pl or in writing to the Administrator's address.
3. Personal data:

Contractors will be processed in order to conclude and perform the contract. The legal basis for the processing of personal data is the contract concluded with the Contractor or actions leading to the conclusion of such a contract (Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR).

Personal data will also be processed in order to fulfill the legal obligations incumbent on the Administrator related to accounting, tax law (in order to settle for the service provided, etc.), pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c GDPR and other legal acts, as well as for archival purposes (after the end of the original purpose) - pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c GDPR in connection with with the relevant special regulations. The data may be processed (if necessary) in order to pursue or defend against claims, which is the legitimate interest of the Administrator based on art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f GDPR.

a) persons representing the Contractor, will be processed on the basis of the legal obligation referred to in art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c of the GDPR resulting from the provisions of law specifying the authorization to represent - in the scope of validity of contracts and proper representation of the parties for the purpose of concluding and proper performance of this contract. Providing this data is a condition for the conclusion of the contract or the validity of the actions taken.

b) persons indicated by the Contractor as persons to contact/implement the contract (name and surname, business contact details, place of work) will be processed in the legitimate interest referred to in art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f of the GDPR, in order to conclude and properly implement this contract (Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR).

The data may be processed (if necessary) in order to pursue or defend against claims, which is the legitimate interest of the Administrator based on art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f GDPR.

Personal data The data administrator obtained from the Contractor who indicated you as the person authorized to represent/contact or perform the contract.

1. Personal data will be disclosed to persons authorized by the personal data administrator, entities authorized under the law. In addition, the data will be entrusted on the basis of an appropriate legal instrument, the so-called processing entities, mainly suppliers / service technicians of IT software / accounting and financial services, services in the field of personal data protection. In addition, to the extent that constitutes public information, the data will be disclosed to anyone interested in such information or published in the Administrator's BIP.

2. Your personal data will be stored for the duration of the contract and for the period required by applicable law after its expiry, in order to archive data or pursue claims. The data will be stored for archival purposes no longer than it results from the provisions of the Act of 14 July 1983 on national archival resources and archives.

1. You have the right to:

- a) pursuant to art. 15 of the GDPR, the right to access your personal data, including the right to obtain a copy of the data;
 - b) pursuant to art. 16 GDPR, the right to request rectification (correction) of personal data;
 - c) the right to delete data - is available under the conditions and under the conditions set out in art. 17 GDPR,
 - d) the right to limit processing - is granted under the conditions and under the conditions set out in Art. 18 GDPR,
 - e) the right to transfer personal data - is granted under the conditions and under the conditions set out in art. 20 GDPR,
 - f) object to the processing of data (Article 21 of the GDPR), the objection may be raised against the processing of data by the Administrator for the Administrator's legitimate purposes for reasons related to your particular situation.
 - g) the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body (President of the Personal Data Protection Office),
2. Personal data will not be used for automated decision-making or profiling referred to in art. 22.
3. Providing the Contractor's personal data is voluntary, however, it is a condition for the conclusion and performance of the contract. The consequence of not providing personal data is the inability to conclude and perform the contract.

You are entitled to:

- the right to object due to a particular situation. You may object to the processing of data by the Administrator for legitimate purposes of the Administrator (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR) for reasons related to your particular situation. You should then indicate to us a particular situation which, in your opinion, justifies us ceasing the processing covered by the objection. We will stop processing your data for these purposes, unless we demonstrate that there are valid, legitimate grounds for processing that override your interests, rights and freedoms, or that your data is necessary for us to establish, investigate or defend claims. If, according to the Administrator's assessment, your interests are more important than the Administrator's interests, he will be obliged to stop processing your personal data for these purposes.
