

UNGUARDED, MONITORED AND PAID CAR PARK REGULATIONS
FOR CARS, VANS AND BUSES
DOMUS MATER

§ 1 ORGANIZATION OF THE CAR PARK

1. The parking area is an integral part of the Domus Mater accommodation and conference facility, hereinafter referred to as the "Facility". The owner and manager of the facility is the Congregation of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, hereinafter referred to as the "Manager".
2. On behalf of the Manager, activities related to the administration of the parking lot are performed by the director of Domus Mater.
3. The parking lot is open 24 hours a day, every day of the week.
4. By entering the parking lot, the user concludes a parking space rental agreement with the Facility under the terms and conditions specified in these regulations and the price list annexed to the regulations.
5. The parking lot is unguarded, monitored and paid. The fee for using the parking lot is collected at the reception of the Facility. By entering the parking area, the user agrees to pay the appropriate fee.

§ 2 CAR PARK USERS RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Each vehicle user, by entering the parking area, accepts the provisions of these regulations and agrees to strictly comply with them.
2. The user is obliged to protect the vehicle against unauthorized persons entering its interior by using its security systems.
3. The user is obliged not to leave items in the vehicle that are not part of the car's manufacturing equipment.
4. The vehicle user is responsible for any damage caused to Domus Mater and third parties in the parking lot.

§ 3 RESPONSIBILITIES OF DOMUS MATER

1. Domus Mater is not responsible for the loss or damage of vehicles in the parking lot. It is also not responsible for items left in the parking lot, both inside and outside the vehicles.
2. Domus Mater's liability for traffic damage to vehicles and persons using the parking lot caused by the actions of other users or third parties is excluded.
3. The parking space rental agreement expires when the user leaves the parking lot.
4. Domus Mater has the exclusive right to decide on closing and opening the parking lot on the dates set by it, and may also decide to temporarily exclude the parking lot from use or change its operating hours.
5. If the user violates the provisions of these regulations, the Manager may terminate the parking space rental agreement immediately without notice and apply the measures necessary to restore the condition in accordance with the regulations, including by removing the vehicle from the parking lot.

§ 4 CONDITIONS OF USE OF THE PARKING PARK

1. In the parking lot it is prohibited to:
 - a) smoke tobacco products or use open flames outside designated places,
 - b) consume alcoholic beverages or take intoxicants,
 - c) pollute the parking lot (in particular throwing waste, garbage, cigarette butts),
 - d) violate public order (e.g. by intentionally making noise, performing or playing loud music),
 - e) wash or vacuum the vehicle, repair it, replace coolants, fuel or oil,
 - f) leave (without justification) the vehicle with the engine running,
 - g) service a vehicle and/or refuel,
 - h) leave children unattended in the vehicle,
 - i) leave animals unattended in the vehicle,
 - j) move around on bicycles, roller skates or skateboards,
 - k) run a business, advertise or canvass without the consent of the parking lot owner,
 - l) allow the entry of presence of unauthorized persons,
 - m) tow vehicles, except for the cases specified in these regulations,
 - n) drive vehicles with trailers, articulated and special vehicles,
 - o) drive vehicles carrying flammable, corrosive or explosive materials,
 - p) drive vehicles with leaks causing leakage of dangerous substances (e.g. fuel) or dirty substances, as well as vehicles carrying dangerous materials, in particular flammable, corrosive, explosive and other materials posing a threat to life, health or property
2. The parking lot is a traffic zone and the provisions of the Road Traffic Act ('Dz. U. z 2012 r. poz. 1137 z późn. zm.') apply there. The maximum speed of vehicles in the parking lot is 10 km/h.
3. Parking lot users are obliged to:
 - a) maintain cleanliness in the parking lot,
 - b) comply with fire protection regulations and sanitary regulations,
 - c) comply with the instructions of Domus Mater employees responsible for security and order.

All complaints and requests regarding the use of the parking lot should be submitted to the Domus Mater reception.
