Information clause

1. The administrator of your personal data is Opal Investments sp. z o.o. with its seat in Wrocław at ul. Św. Antoniego 2/4, 50-073 Wrocław, registered in the register of entrepreneurs kept by the District Court for Wrocław - Fabryczna, 6th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, KRS: 0000253419, REGON: 140488361, NIP: 5272501581, share capital: PLN 50,000, contact: europeum@europeum.pl, hereinafter referred to as the Administrator.

2. Your personal data are processed in order to verify the identity/identification of persons staying at the Europeum Hotel in Wrocław with minors and their relations in connection with the Administrator's fulfillment of legal obligations arising from the Act of May 13, 2016 on counteracting threats of crime in sexual background and protection of minors (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 1304, as amended), ensuring the safety of minors, i.e. performing tasks in the public interest, Art. 6 section 1 letter e GDPR. In the remaining scope, data processing is based on voluntary consent of Art. 6 section 1 letter a GDPR.

3. Your personal data may be made available to entities and bodies authorized under applicable law, as well as to entities with which the Administrator has concluded data processing agreements in connection with the provision of services provided to him.

4. Your personal data will be stored for the time necessary to achieve the purposes listed in point. 2, but not shorter than the limitation period for claims arising from legal provisions and the deadlines specified in the archiving provisions.

5. You have the right to request access to your personal data, rectification, deletion or limitation of processing, the right to transfer data and the right to object to processing.

6. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body - the President of the Personal Data Protection Office - if you believe that the processing of your data violates the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation.

7. Your personal data is not subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.
