

REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF PLAYROOM AT THE BELWEDER HOTEL IN USTROŃ BY CHILDREN OF HOTEL GUESTS

1. It is obligatory for parents/guardians of children using the Playroom to read these Regulations.
2. Staying in the Playroom shall be tantamount to accepting these Regulations.
3. Parent/guardian of a child bears sole responsibility for the non-compliance with these Regulations.
4. Parent/guardian of a child should familiarise himself/herself with the equipment in the Playroom. Leaving the child in the Playroom means that the parent/guardian agrees that the child may use all the equipment in the Playroom.
5. The Playroom is open daily from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
6. Parents/guardians of children are responsible for the safety of children in the playroom.
7. The equipment in the Playroom may only be used in accordance with its intended purpose and function.
8. It is forbidden to:
 - climb on the structures intended for playing,
 - push and hit other children,
 - throw toys or other items present in the Playroom,
 - take any equipment or part of it away from the Playroom ,
 - consume alcohol on the premises of the Playroom,
 - use narcotics or similar substances in the Playroom,
 - smoke cigarettes on the premises of the Playroom,
 - bring animals into the Playroom.
9. After the kids have finished playing, they or their parents/guardians should put the toys away to the designated place.
10. The Hotel shall not be liable for any injuries resulting from improper use of the Playroom equipment or the use of equipment in a manner that is inconsistent with its intended use or function.
11. The Hotel shall not be liable for any consequences of accidents or actions of third parties.
12. Parents/guardians of children are liable for damage to persons or property caused by their children.
13. The Hotel shall not be responsible for any belongings left in the Playroom, especially mobile phones, toys and other items.
14. Only indoor footwear and socks are allowed in the Playroom.
15. If a child suffers a physical injury in the Playroom, it must be immediately reported to the Playroom staff, otherwise the child will be deemed to have suffered the injury elsewhere.
16. A child between 3 and 13 years of age may stay in the Playroom accompanied by playworkers, provided that parents/guardians of the child have previously submitted a declaration of consent, available from the playworkers, for the child to participate in activities organised in the Playroom. Children under 3 years of age may stay in or use the Playroom (including participation in play activities) exclusively in the presence of a parent/guardian.
17. Due to epidemiological reasons, the Hotel reserves the right to deny sick children access to the Playroom.
18. In order to ensure the safety of children, surveillance cameras are installed in the Playroom. Recordings may be made available to parents/guardians only in justified circumstances, especially in case of accident or damage.
19. Any remarks and objections concerning the Playroom may be reported to the Playroom's staff or at the Hotel's reception desk.
20. The Regulations may be changed at any time and the changes shall be effective from the date of the announcement at the reception desk of the Belweder Hotel or on the date indicated.
21. These Regulations shall come into effect on 15 March 2017.
